Did you miss it? 29 March, National Vietnam Veterans Day, King's Mountain Post 24 hosted a remembrance ceremony at the Johnson City/Washington County Veterans Memorial Park (Market Street & Veterans Way). Legionnaire Ray Dartez provided remarks contrasting his time serving during the Vietnam War and his 2023 return visit to the largely restored and modernized country. Ray intends to bring his photo collection of the trip to a future Meeting of Members.
